CMF&A's Circular No. 14 of 2022-23

Re: Discontinuation of benefit due to 5 (five) years post-training service for Teachers working at KMCP Schools under Education Dept, KMC

Whereas, in terms of Office Order No. D.M.C.(P)G/07/2006-07 dated 27.05.2006 of DMG(P), teachers of KMCP Schools, who possess Certificate for completion of Teachers Training or equivalent, are being allowed to enjoy the next higher scale benefit in terms of C.M.F&A's Circular No. 12 of 1985-86 dated 09.07.1985 on completion of 5(five) years service from the date of publication of result of the said training course,

And whereas, the Recruitment Regulations for the post of Teacher of KMCP School has been modified to make Primary Teachers Training or its equivalent qualification mandatory for applying for the post of Teacher in KMCP Schools, on the basis of recommendation of MIC vide its meeting dated 20.09.2012 and duly communicated vide D.M.C.(P)'s Circular No. 42/VIII/2012-13 dated 04.10.2012,

And whereas, Municipal Commissioner vide his Office Order No. 29 of 2013-14 dated 21.06.2013, directed all KMCP Teachers, who does not have requisite elementary qualification, to upgrade their qualification as per the provision of RTE Act, 2009,

And whereas, most of the previously recruited un-trained Teachers have upgraded their qualification as per RTE Act 2009 and newly recruited Teachers are already trained as reported by Education Dept,

Therefore, the benefit accruing due to 5(five) years of post-training service as per C.M.F&A's Circular No. 12 of 1985-86 dated 09.07.1985 has now become infructuous and is being discontinued with immediate effect as per recommendation of Education Dept.

This will take immediate effect.
