Municipal Commissioner's Circular No. 10 of 2019- 2020

Sub : Civic arrangement to combat Cyclone FANI

As per information received from National Emergency Response Centre and Department of Disaster Management & Civil Defence, Govt. of West Bengal, there is likelihood of Cyclone FANI to move towards Bengal. Expected wind speed and rainfall of the said cyclone is given below date wise:-

| Sl. No. | Date       | Wind Speed | Rainfall |
|---------|------------|------------|----------|
| 1.      | 02.05.2019 | 60 km/hr   |          |
| 2.      | 03.05.2019 | 85 km/hr   | 7-11 cm  |
| 3.      | 04.05.2019 | 115 km/hr  | 7-20 cm  |

Considering the ensuing Cyclone FANI, all concerned Controlling Officers of Civil Engineering Department, Sewerage and Drainage Department, Building Department, Parks and Squares Department, Lighting Department, SWM Department and Municipal Secretary Department to take necessary action as per instructions given below. In addition to this, it is also requested to alert all Borough Control Room as well as Central Control Room. All concerned departments will keep skeleton gang on 01.05.2019.

Br. Ex. Engineers (Civil), Civil Engineering Department are hereby requested to remain open the office and arrange the skeleton gang as and when required. Br. Ex. Engineers should be made available on phone and will control the entire arrangements.

Parks & Squares Department will deploy necessary men and machineries to attend the emergent situation for removal of uprooted trees including broken branches of trees etc. throughout the city.

Building Department will deploy gang and officials to attend the emergent situation.

Lighting Department will arrange to remove uprooted lamp post and traction and disconnection of electricity from the lamp post and all other necessary measures as and when required.

Sewerage and Drainage Department will arrange to alert drainage pumping stations for removal of water logging.

SWM Department will depute and arrange necessary men and machineries to attend the emergent situation.

Municipal Secretary Department will arrange and provide sufficient relief material as and when required.

All concerned departments are requested to make necessary arrangement from their end so that service can be extended on war footing basis on actual incident of uprooted trees, removal of water logging and other disaster activities. Department may deploy men and machinery from their end for which post facto approval will be given later on, on actual cost basis.
