Municipal Commissioner's Circular no. 33 of 2020-21

Sub.: Prompt action on the direction of Hon'ble Courts

It has been discussed time and again that we need to take prompt action on the court matters specially matters where a direction has been issued on the KMC authorities. In order to ensure the expeditious justice and also to avoid complications, all court orders should be complied forthwith unless there are good and sufficient reasons to appeal against the order. This will avoid unnecessary embarrassment to the KMC authority in the court due to non-compliance in time.

It is, therefore, ordered that:

1. All court orders specially issued by Hon'ble Supreme Court or Hon'ble High Courts or Hon'ble Tribunals: a specific proposal for compliance or for filing appeal where there is good and sufficient reasons should be put up to the Municipal Commissioner within 2 (two) days either through e-Office (marked as urgent) or in physical file by hand to ensure prompt action.
In any case it should not take more than 2 (two) days to put up the matter; if the matter is very old and complicated, in that case also the Municipal Commissioner should be briefed positively within 2 (two) days and seek permission for extra time if required to fully comply with the matter.
2. In the matters where a writ/ petition has been filed in any court, the concerned Officer should take prompt action for preparing statement of fact and formal briefing to the Ld. State Advocate to ensure that the stand of State (KMC) is adequately presented before the Hon'ble Court.
