

Municipal Commissioner's Circular Number 34.....of 2019-20 dated 11.07.2019

Re: Collection of GST upon booking of Community Halls of KMC

It has been decided that booking of the Community Halls of KMC will be done by the SW&UPA Dept with effect from 01.07.2019.

The booking amount and the GST, if applicable, thereupon following extant provisions of the GST Act will be received through the Common Collection System of KMC upon generation of demand notice showing the booking amount and charges including GST separately.

On receipt of payment against a particular demand, the CGST, SGST and IGST components of GST and any other charge leviable, will be received in the respective B.I. codes of SWUPA Dept to be generated for these purposes specifically.

As the process is being developed by the I.T. Dept and may take some time, it is ordered that until the common Collection System for booking of Community Halls rolls out, the GST components on booking amount should be deposited separately to the respective B.I. Codes of the Market Dept (9900/922 for SGST, 9900/923 for CGST and 9900/924 for IGST) to facilitate proper submission of GST returns by KMC.
