The following decisions have been taken in the meeting in respect of Town Vending Committee and as Pre- Scheduled from the previous Town Vending Committee meeting:-


- 1) Reference was drawn to earlier meeting of Town Vending Committee where decision was taken that there has to be clear balance between the convenience of the vendors vis-a-vis convenience of the pedestrian. It was also decided that no vending shall be allowed on the footpath and vending should be confined one third area of the footpath. It was felt necessary that as per the decision of the TVC, a joint team consisting of KMC, KP and representative of Hawkers Associations who are member of the TVC should be formed to do physical survey in the different markets and simultaneously ensure compliance with the decision of the TVC. It was decided that a Survey shall be started to cross check encroachment on Black Top by Hawkers, &/or encroachment of Footpath area exceeding 1/3 of the footpath area from 07.11.2022 till 21/11/2022 involving the members of Town Vending Committee initially in prominent Vending Zones under Gariahat PS, Shyampukur PS and New Market PS. It was decided that the Hawkers Association will be represented by Shri Saktipada Mandal [M:9830033039] & Shri Debashis Das [M:9433067774]. The Traders Association will be represented by Shri Rajesh Pandey [M: 9123732323]. It was also decided in the meeting that Kolkata Police will be represented by a Police team led by OC/ Addl OC or any others





suitable competent officers of concerned Police Station. As per decision in the meeting KMC will be represented by officials / staff from the SWM, Market, and Car Parking department. SWM department will be the Nodal Department in this regard. TVC has already published draft list of applicants. The list has been finally finalised and published. This joint team shall work with this final published list.

- 2) Ch. Manager (Personnel), KMC will take up the matter with concerned controlling officers of the SWM, Market, and Car Parking department and prepare a duty list of a total of Six- Personnel for each day for survey duty on working days starting from 07.11.2022 to 21.11.2022. Persons should be deployed from this list for each team by the Municipal Secretary.
- 3) On the matter of Complaint received from Head Master Town School, Kolkata due to occupation and encroachment of footpath in front of the school by hawkers it was confirmed by OC, Shyampukur PS that he had already taken suitable steps and the problem has been resolved. However he stated that he will take up the matter with Headmaster Town School once more to reconfirm the status.
- 4) On the matter of list of Heritage of Market under KMC area, a list of thirty nine (39) markets was presented before the TVC by Ch.Manager Market. It was decided and adopted that the markets which are aged above 50 years may be earmarked as Heritage Market and the others as Natural markets.
- 5) The letter no. 167/HQ/C dated 22.07.2022 of Jt. C.P. addressed to Municipal Commissioner, KMC to constitute a joint committee for identification was discussed. It was decided that the same committee while taking survey and compliance work shall also identify the vending and non-vending zone.
