In terms of the decisions of previous TVC meetings and subsequent suggestions received from the TVC members in the TVC meeting held on **07/02/2024**, the following decisions are taken:-

1. Pursuant to the order of Hon'ble High Court dated 19<sup>th</sup> Jan 2024 [in the matter of Tridhara Construction Vs Kolkata Municipal Corporation and Ors.] the hawkers in front 111 College Street will be relocated at Suitable location after physical

inspection so that ingress & egress of 111, College Street building is cleared. CME(Civil) and SWM-I Department will execute this decision with the assistance of Bowbazer Police Station after physical inspection.

2. Representative of the Oberoi Grand Hotel and representative of the related 13 hawkers will be asked to appear before the Chairman and other members of Town Vending Committee (TVC) in the next Meeting in order to resolve their issues through hearing.
3. The street vendors who are submitting applications before KMC for Certificate of Vending (COV) are bound to comply with the due responsibilities of vendors as laid down in Rule 14 of the West Bengal Urban Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Rules 2018. Any deviation from the aforesaid rules will make them liable for cancellation of respective Certificate of Vending.
4. A proposal has been placed before the Committee to make the surrounding area of CMO building, KMC into 'Night Market' to be operated from 6-00 pm to 4-00 am after restriction in traffic movement. This proposal will be examined and explored by the KMC authority and Kolkata Police. Thereafter it may be sent to Govt. of West Bengal for obtaining necessary approval.
5. Both the pavements along S N Banerjee Road will be demarcated into one-third & two-third portion with yellow border on 16/02/2024. Concerned Kolkata Police Station will arrange to draw the yellow line in presence of personnel from CME(Civil), SWM-I, Market and Licence Department of KMC and other TVC members.


