Pursuant to the decisions of previous TVC meetings and subsequent suggestions received from the TVC members in the TVC meeting held on **11/01/2024**, the following decisions are taken:-

1. (P & S) Department of KMC may be requested to make available for relocation of hawkers at 6 (six) nos. of roadside garden situated at Humayun Place in front of at Sriram Arcade, Ward No. 46 under Br. -VI. On such approval, it will be demolished by SWM Department with the assistance of New Market Police Station. CME (SWM) will take necessary action in this regard.
2. There will be no Hawkers on Black Top and on 2/3<sup>rd</sup> portion of footpath which is earmarked for pedestrians at New Market area particularly on Lindsay Street,


Humayun Place and Chowringee Place where demarcation on footpaths has already been made.

3. Necessary notice to the street vendors will be given through miking by the members of TVC along with local police station and representatives from KMC with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024 so that strict enforcement shall be ensured.
4. As suggested by TVC, KMC will examine and explore the issue of construction of footpath at Bertram Street for rehabilitation of Street Vendors.
5. The street vendors will be regulated on 58 major crossings of Kolkata through demarcation of footpath with yellow marking. This programme will be commenced initially with the demarcation of footpath at the intersections of A.J.C Bose Road with Lenin Sarani and S. N. Banerjee Road.
6. An Enforcement Committee will be constituted comprising the following members:-
  - a) Personnel from local Police Station
  - b) Personnel from KMC (SWM /CME (C) /Market /Licence Department. Sri Jagadish Mahato, Addl. Municipal Secretary will be the Nodal Officer from KMC.
  - c) Representative from the TVC Members namely from Debasish Das/Mana Chakraborty/ Bharat Kumar Shah/ Debraj Ghosh


The Committee will monitor implementation of the decisions adopted in TVC Meetings. Since availability of police and that there are no major law and order programme in the city is extremely vital, it is decided that the O.C of local P.S shall co-ordinate and lead the programme. KMC Officer and representative of TVC member shall make themselves available accordingly for enforcement. The mobile number of KMC nodal officer and representative members has been shared with Kolkata Police for ease of co-ordination.

7. A team of TVC members will cause an inspection to the Sisir Market and Koley Market at Sealdah for the purpose of regulating the street vendors who are using the market terrace and carriage way.
8. TVC members will explore the issue of rehabilitation of the hawkers at 111 College Street in ward 47, Br-VI to comply with the order of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dated 5<sup>th</sup> January 2024.
9. Local Police, TVC members, CME (SWM) and DG (Civil) will take necessary steps to execute strict adherence of the street vending rules for the hawkers of Hatibagan with formalities as applicable.
10. The encroachment of footpath at College Street in front of Calcutta Medical College will be removed by SWM Department with the assistance of CME (C) Department in presence of local police station and TVC Members.
