The following decisions have been taken in the meeting in respect of Town Vending Committee and as pre-scheduled from the previous Town Vending Committee meeting:-

- 1) That one representative of the Hawkers Unions submits that it would be convenient for the Vendors to access the data in Vendors List published on the official website of KMC if such data be segregated in Ward Wise format for their easy access and understanding of the vendors' data. Accordingly it has been decided in the said meeting that KMC will look into the issue and segregate the list and arrange it ward wise as per feasibility for which K.M.C.'s IT Department will do the needful in assistance with SW&UPA Department.
- 2) One Mr. Asit Kumar Saha President of Central Kolkata Sahid Kshudiram Bose Hawkers Welfare Association submitted a petition for his inclusion in TVC as member. It has been decided in the said meeting that Mr. Asit Kumar Saha representing the Central Kolkata Sahid Khudiram Bose Hawkers Welfare Association is being made a co-opted member of the Town Vending Committee.

The Police Authority was represented by the Joint Commissioner of Police, Head Quarter to attend the said meeting and while discussion he submits that very shortly he will sit with the Officer-in-Charges of the respective police stations and will decide on the vending zone at the earliest and inform the same to the Town Vending Committee as early as possible. He will be issuing necessary direction to the concerned police stations for identification of the vending zone within jurisdiction of the concerned police stations.

- 4) Many of the authorities present in the said meeting raised the point related to use of plastic sheets as shade over the vending units as probable cause of devastating fire. It has been decided by the Town Vending Committee that all the vendors will remove the plastic sheets used as shed over their vending units within 7 days and all the Hawkers Unions have taken their responsibility to implement the said decision. Moreover in this respect K.M.C. has already given a direction upon the Kolkata Police to take initiative towards implementation for removal of those plastic sheet used as shade in the said vending stalls/units.
- 5) It has been decided in the same meeting that after compliances on the above issues, identification of the Vending Zones by Kolkata Police and subsequent finalization of the said Vending Zones by Town Vending Committee, necessary steps will be taken by the Licence Department and Market Department, KMC towards issuance of Certificate of Vending to the eligible vendors.
