Minutes of the Meeting regarding the constitution of the Town Vending Committee for Kolkata city, held on 27th September, 2018 in the Conference Hall-I of the KMC.

Meeting was held as per the direction of the Urban Development & Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal, vide memo No. 562(125)/MA/O/C-4/1A-10/2011 (Pt. II) dated-07-08-2018 and was chaired by Municipal Commissioner, KMC. Hon'ble M-MIC (Parks & Gardens, Sports, Advt. and Parking), KMC and Hon'ble M-MIC (Market) co-chaired the meeting.

The attendance sheet is enclosed separately.

The back ground was briefed by the Municipal Secretary highlighting the salient points of "The Street vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of the Street Vending) Act, 2014" and the Rules framed thereunder by the State Government. After the initial briefing, Hon'ble M-MIC (Parks & Gardens) welcomed the participants and expressed the faith that the concerns of the street vendors as well as of the pedestrians will be addressed suitably and apprised that KMC, Kolkata Police alongwith the other authorities have taken the first step in the right direction. After detailed deliberation and taking into consideration the various opinion and suggestions the following points were discussed.

1. Regarding the Confirmation of Town Vending Committee - After detailed discussion with the participants from the Vendors Associations, the constitution of the 18 member Town Vending Committee for Kolkata was hereby confirmed and the members constituting the Town Vending Committee are as follows:


